

Early in 2016, work began on the construction of a new, state of the art carpentry and joinery workshop at Goole College. Work was completed ready for their September 2016. The project was delivered in partnership with the Humber Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP) and was supported with £0.375m from the Government's Local Growth Fund.

Visiting the site, two years after its completion, it is clear to see the impact that the advancements are having; not only on the learners but also the training staff. The workshop was designed to deliver a provision that provided the vital skills needed by local businesses, enhancing the local skill set within the community. Staff have embraced the use of mobile technology within the learning environment, using QR codes and video tutorials which are allowing learners to develop their skills at their own pace; providing additional learning opportunities for more advanced learners, whilst offering additional support for those that require it. Feedback from the learners clearly emphasises their appreciation for the differentiation shown through a variety of teaching and learning methods within the workshop.

The current co-hort are collaboratively working on producing 100 white crosses to be displayed in Goole for the Armistice Centenary, enhancing the college's community links, showing the enhanced benefits of vocational learning.

The LGF funding received was also invested in the college's Business & Logistics Centre, in partnership with HCUK Training, which has enabled a bespoke training and skills facility offering Business and Management programmes, as well as conference and meeting facilities which have been well received by local employers and businesses alike.
